Where adhesive labels are recommended, these will be available at the show if required and apart from jars, will only be used where exhibits will be attached to a presentation board in the show.

- Junior Classes giving specific ages are only for those age groups**  
***i.e. 4 - 5yrs., 6 - 9yrs., and 10 - 13yrs.***
- All entry forms should be delivered to the Secretary on or before the **6th February 2020. Only entries registered with Secretary will be accepted on day of Show.**  
Entries are 20p per item
- All entries for the show must be grown or made by the exhibitor
- Where a maximum size is indicated, **NO LARGER SIZES ACCEPTED**
- Unless otherwise stated, all bulbs must be grown in soil or fibre.
- All exhibits must be delivered to the Hall and staged by **11-30a.m.** on day of the show.  
The show will be **opened to the public at 3.00p.m.**
- The Judge's decision will be final.
- Trophies presented at 4.30p.m
- Exhibits to be cleared from the hall immediately after the presentations.
- Winning Place Cards to be presented by exhibitor when collecting prize monies.

**Prize money to be collected from the Committee Room after presentations.**
